Leisure Centre Rules

You must agree to abide by the rules governing access to the Leisure Centre and use of the Squash Courts and Swimming Pool as specified by the Directors.

You must understand that contravention of any such rules will lead to your access key being disabled, and only being re-enabled at the discretion of the Directors.

The rules regarding access to the Leisure Centre will be displayed in the Leisure Centre. The rules are currently as follows:

- 1 The term 'Resident' means either a Shareholder, or a Tenant of a Shareholder where the right to use the Leisure Centre has been transferred to the Tenant.
- 2 Right of access to the Leisure Centre shall be restricted to:
 - a Resident adults.
 - b Resident children under 16 years of age when accompanied and supervised at all times by an adult.
 - c Residents between the age of 16 and 18 who may be accompanied by one guest aged 16 years and over.
 - d Residents over the age of 18 may be accompanied by a maximum of two adult guests and two child guests provided that the child guests are supervised at all times by an adult.
 - e Such other persons as shall from time to time be authorised in writing by the Directors. Applications should be forwarded to the Centre Manager.
- 3 The following additional rules apply to the use of the Swimming Pool:
 - a When resident children, child guests, vulnerable persons or persons with restricted mobility are in the swimming pool area an adult must be in the swimming pool area with them at all times.
 - b Inflatable items must be used responsibly and with consideration for other pool users.
 - c No food, drink or any consumables other than water in plastic containers are to be taken into the swimming pool area.
 - d The swimming pool shall not be used for financial gain.
Paid swimming lessons must not take place.
- 4 Residents are responsible for the safety and behaviour of their children and guests.
- 5 Residents whose keys have been disabled are not eligible to use the facilities of the Leisure Centre as a guest of a Resident.

Contravention of the rules will lead to your access key being disabled, and only being re-enabled at the discretion of the Directors.
